

COURSE CURRENCY STATUS: Current

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to someone in line with first aid guidelines determined by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and other Australian national peak clinical bodies. The trainee is required to be able to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

DURATION

The duration for this course is 18 hours (mixture of online learning and practical assessment sessions) and a period for re-submission opportunities and assessments at the end of the course.

COURSE DEMANDS

Face to face classes are offered to students. Scheduling can be amended to suit learner cohort requirements including further training if required. It is anticipated that the course length will be split into two terms and will be subject to the requirements. The recommended/ scheduled dates

COURSE DELIVERY

A blended delivery mode is employed including a simulated environment and face to face training that will take place in Southern Education's training facility. Face to face training will be provided for out of state classes through e-mail, telephone, zoom and any other processes employed by Southern Education to assist in delivery. Face to face training classes will consist of groups up to a maximum 24 students. It is however anticipated

that an average class size will consist of approximately 16 students in attendance at any one time.

Online learning material for the course will be provided to the student. Students will read relevant sections of the online learning material prior to delivery of practical training.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

A Pre-Training Review is completed by students based on their prior training. On completion of the Pre-Training Review, Southern Education determines if the course is suitable for the student and whether it addresses their learning needs.
